The Club Rules provide for the vice president to act in the president's role in absence of a president. Family and other commitments prevent me from taking on the president's role for an extended period, so the August committee meeting resolved to seek expressions of interest from any member who might be interested in taking on this important position.

The Club Rules provide for the committee to appoint a replacement for any committee position that should become vacant. In the event that there is more than one expression of interest, the committee will determine a process to select an appointee.

The role statement is attached. The person appointed to this role would be supported by a capable, enthusiastic and experienced committee, and of course be able to draw on my support as vice president, and of our secretary, who is the previous president.


