### **From the Vice President ...**

How quickly the year has gone!

It's time for entries for 'Image of the Year' to be submitted ... please bring your prints to the November meeting, and upload all images as usual. Hopefully members are busy collecting images for entry into the first competition of the new year 'Colourful Street Photography' with images taken on mobile phones. The October meeting of the committee discussed a number of items which require your consideration and / or input.

1. The weekend away planned for the end of November has been cancelled due to a clash of events in Geelong making accommodation a problem. Following this decision, the committee proposed a weekend away in late February or early March 2024. The committee is looking for volunteers to form a small team to plan this event. If you are interested / prepared to commit to this, please discuss with Ron ASAP.
2. Given the large turnout of WCC members at the Bright Festival of Photography, the committee felt that a November weekend away wouldn't be viable in 2024 but proposed that members be encouraged to consider attending the 2024 BFOP, and this be a weekend away for our club.
3. Members would be aware that the 2023 / 2024 budget is very tight. The committee would be happy to approve a fundraiser event such as a Bunnings Sausage Sizzle if there was a (small) team prepared to investigate opportunities and organise it. Please let Bruce know if you are available for this team. (A larger team of members would be sought to staff the event.)

Your committee is still keen to hear from members who are willing to support the work of the coordinators of areas such as Outings (by scouting and suggesting locations and assisting with planning), or the Editor (by soliciting articles from members, or being a regular contributor).

While on a long solo drive recently I listened to a few podcasts. One that that members may find interesting was the *Epic Photography Podcast* (Episode 020) in which Scott Kelby and Fernando Santos discuss the importance of printing photos, and some of the problems encountered in the process.

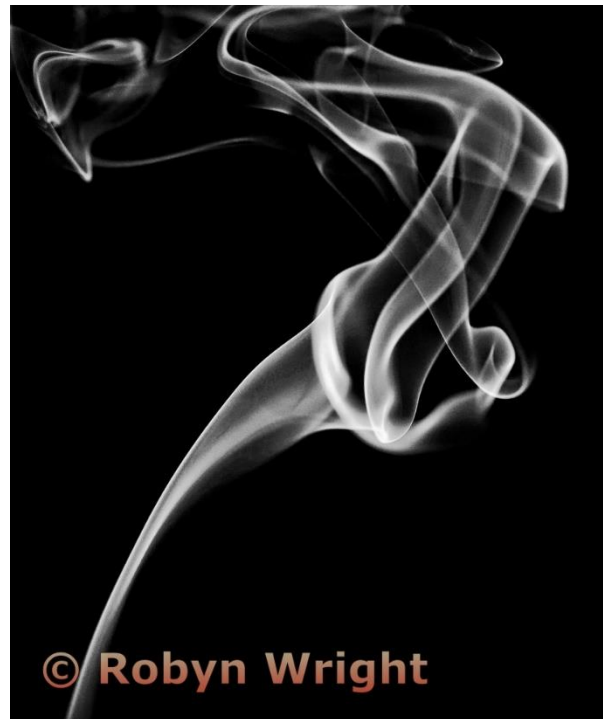

The club was also stretched to provide photographers to cover the Geoff Watt Fun Run on Sunday, so this was a very busy weekend for the members involved.

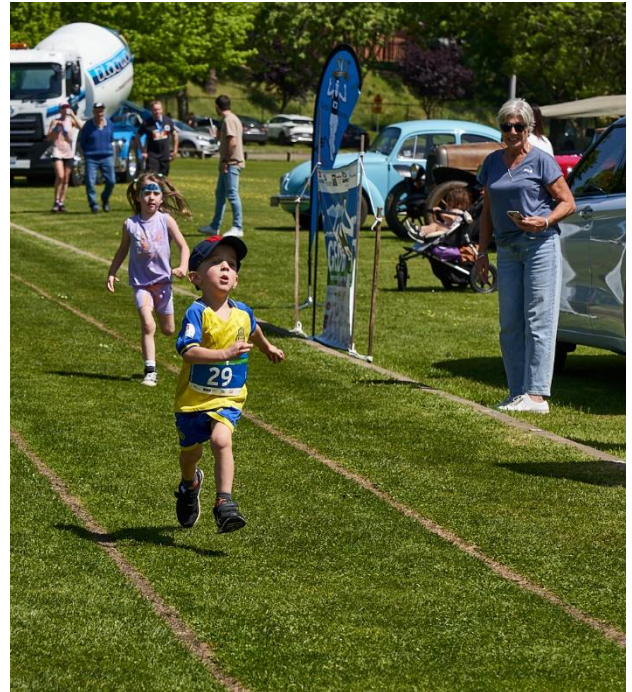

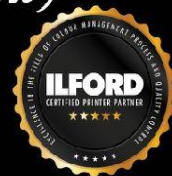
