It would be fair to say that some of the entries challenge the conventional definition of 'portrait' but there are some outstanding images, and even more powerful seeing them at actual size.

Among recent member achievements it's appropriate to acknowledge Terrie O'Dwyer for her Merit in the VAPS Interclub, David Woodcock for Chairman's Choice Award in the APS Australia Cup, and Louise Sedgman for various achievements in the Australian Photographic Prize (two semi-finalist awards and four commended awards out of the seven images entered)

Our August meeting will feature the judging of 'Seasons', as well as opportunities to share news from the Interclub, last weekend's outing to Melbourne, and importantly, catch up with each other.

With the return of travelling members, the August committee meeting will consider the vacant position of president, finalise responsibilities for individual committee members, as well as issues raised in each of the portfolio areas.



For those who have prints around the house (matted or unmatted) that are not hung on walls etc and need a place to store them safely this may prove to be a useful addition.




Works well. They got me white but I think it comes in a couple of other shades. Mike Moore


